Good management rewards communal farmers

Every year during the NWGA national congress, the top five shearing sheds in the various regions of the Eastern Cape are rewarded for their outstanding efforts towards developing sheep projects that result in an increased income from wool. The criteria are based on the total number of bales of wool and bin bales produced for the season, average micron, clean yield and price received.

Region 21 Wool Growers' Association, Springgroove No. 2, in the Ntabethemba district, was selected the regional winner. Members of the association planned a gathering in conjunction with Zoetis and animal health technicians to administer and dose all the animals at the shearing shed. More than 3 978 sheep, including lambs, were drenched with Cydectin Oral.

Zoetis sponsored 35 5-l-containers of Cydectin Oral, which was distributed among the five regional winners. The communal wool producers of Springgroove were ecstatic knowing that their entire flock was protected against all major internal parasites. They thanked Zoetis for this very useful prize.



3 → Veld ram club open day

Another historic day on the calendar of communal farmers was 2 August 2016 when the first veld ram club open day was held on Arundel, John Gary Wardle's farm in the Cathcart district. The stunning rams on display had to undergo a strict selection process, and are considered to be separate and additional to the 3 000 genetically bred rams that will be distributed to rural communities/shearing sheds annually.



4 → Know the status of animal diseases

5 → Fraserburg se wolboere leer by mekaar

'n Jaarlikse toer na medeboere in die Fraserburg-distrik is vanjaar na die AL3 Boerdery onderneem, waar Piet le Roux senior en sy seuns, Pieter en Elmar, reggestaan het om die boere en belangstellendes in te lig oor die boerderypraktyke wat op hul plaas toegepas word.

Kenneth van der Westhuizen, 'n onafhanklike makelaar, het informeel oor versekering, boedels en trusts gesels en die slaggate rondom hierdie onderwerpe uitgewys. Groot was die belangstelling toe daar gefokus is op boerderypraktyke soos korrekte paartye, die voorbereiding van ooie en ramme, lamhokkies, die seleksie van jong vervangingsooie en verskillende voedingspraktyke soos byvoeding, prikkelvoeding en kruipvoeding. Gawie van Wyk, NWKV-produksie-adviseur en Adri de Klerk, 'n skaap- en wolbeampte van BKB, het die boere behoorlik laat dink oor die seleksie van jongooie.

Die AL3 Boerdery was verantwoordelik vir die versorging en voorbereiding van al die veldramme binne Fraserburg se veldramklub. Boere kon terselfdertyd die geleentheid benut om die ramme te besigtig en te merk met die oog op vanjaar se veiling.

Voor huistoegaantyd het boere die veld ingeslaan om na jongooie en ramme, asook lamkruiphokke te gaan kyk.

Shortlisted candidates will be interviewed in Port Elizabeth towards the beginning of December.



Die oplossing is om 'n verskeidenheid metodes tot die boer se beschikking te stel – 'n gereedskapskis van bestuurstoerusting. Die handleiding help die boer om die probleem binne die raamwerk van provinsiale en nasionale wetgewing te bestuur. Dit gee ook wenke oor hoe om die roofdier wat die plaasdier gevang het, te identifiseer. Die gids is nou beskikbaar by lidorganisasies van die Predasiebestuursforum (PMF), naamlik die NWKV, die Rooivleisproduente-organisasie (RPO), Suid-Afrikaanse Sybokhaarkwekersvereniging (Samga) en Wildbedryf SA (WRSA).


Nuwe leierskap vir Wes-Kaapse NWKV

Geskik vir droë lande met 'n opbrengs van 10 tot 14 ton DM/ha/jaar.

Pennisetum (banagras)



CARAJAS

- Geselekteer vir hoër droëmateriaalopbrengs, vinniger hergroei, hoër proteïene en beter verteerbaarheid.
- Hierdie olifantsgraskruising is uiters bestand teen koue en matig tot hoog droogtebestand.
- Baie smaaklik en uiters geskik vir beweiding asook kuilvoer.
- Kuilvoeroopbrengs van meer as 200 ton materiaal (40 tot 50 ton droog) per hektaar per jaar is moontlik onder ideale toestande.

Peulplante



Java is 'n meerjarige peulplant wat heeljaar baie saad produseer en voeg 150 kg stikstof per ha per jaar terug in die grond. Die peulplant kan in arm grond gevestig word en het 'n hoë droogteverweerstand. Dit is smaaklik en het 'n proteïenewaarde van 18 tot 23% en lewer goeie hergroei ná beweiding.

Panicum Maximum (witbuffel)

MOMBASA TANZANIA

Geskik vir besproeiing met 'n opbrengs van 18 tot 30 ton DM/ha/jaar.

Panicum Maximum-kruis

Geskik vir wild en koue toestande. Opbrengs 15 tot 20 ton DM/ha/jaar. Aries is 'n hibried van *P. maximum Aruana* en *P. maximum Centauro*. Aries is koue- en droogtebestand en toon goeie hergroei ná beweiding. Dit is 'n uiters smaaklike gras geskik vir beeste, perde, skape en wild.
