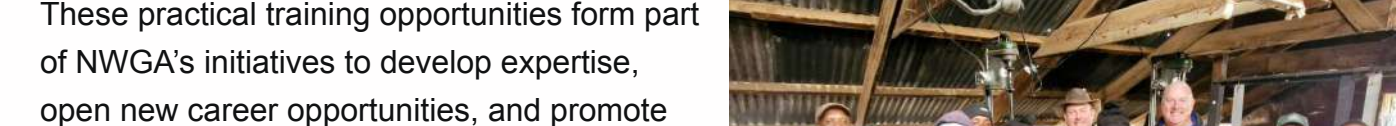
Nuwe wêreldklas uitstalruimte vir makelaars

NWGA's efforts to build skills and create opportunities

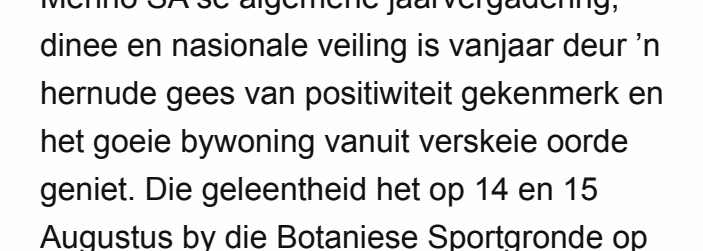
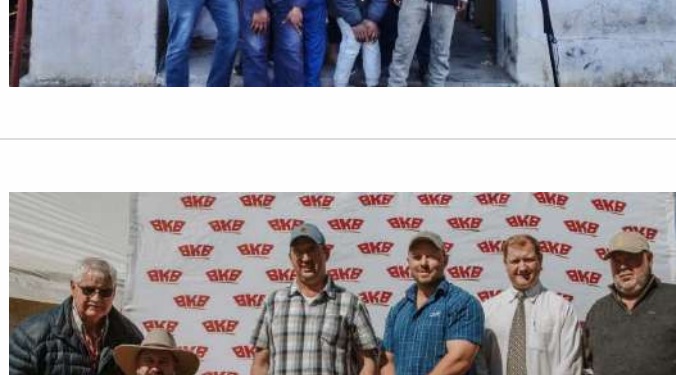
The National Wool Growers' Association (NWGA) recently hosted a sheep shearing and woolpicking course at Brandfontein farm in De Aar. These NWGA shearing courses aim to empower individuals, especially the youth, to start their own shearing businesses or join existing sheep shearing teams.

Participants received sheep shearing training by shearing instructor, Stbuso Galawe and NWGA shearing manager, Izak Klopper.

Students received additional training in wool picking, a key step towards the Springbush Wool Classing Diploma. The wool course was presented by Dr Andries Strauss of the Free State Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (FSDARD) and Eben van Wyk of the NWGA.

These practical training opportunities form part of NWGA's initiatives to develop expertise, open new career opportunities, and promote lasting income sources in rural communities.

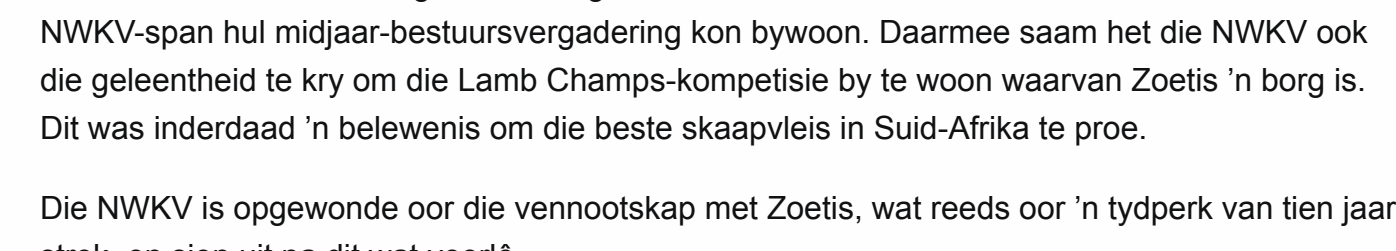
Sheep health – The reward for good practices at shearing sheds

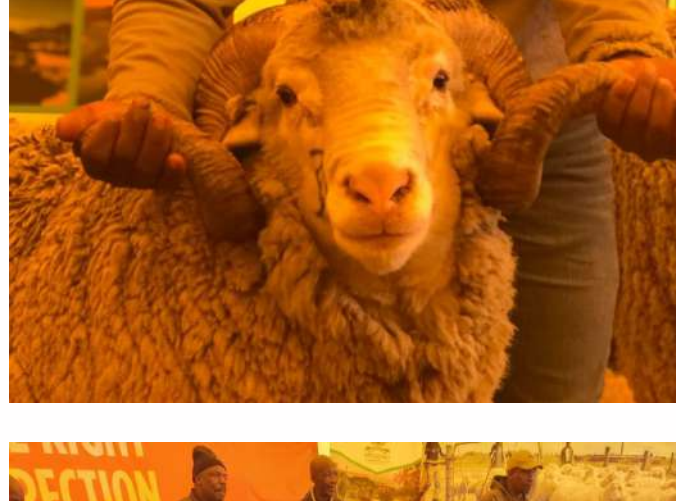


Veehantering vir plaasarbeiders

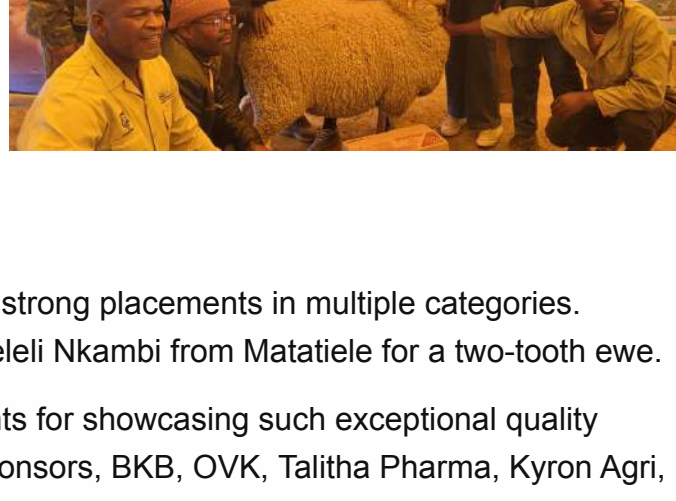

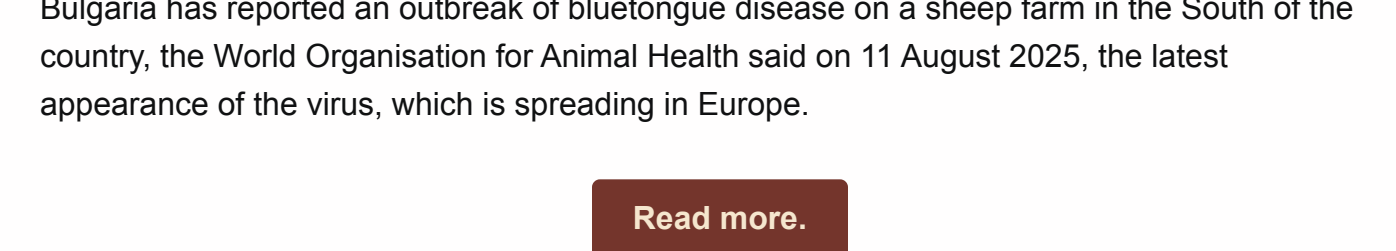

Eradicate flukes before they become a problem

Livestock producers can suffer significant losses if their herds are infected with flukes. Serious cases can even lead to livestock mortalities. Liver fluke affects the liver of ruminants while conical fluke invades the rumen and reticulum. Flukes cause the most damage to the animal's small intestine while in the early stages of development. Fluke infection is best identified through mature egg counts.



Animals generally present with suppressed appetite, weight loss, and diarrhoea. Especially animals in extensive farming operations are prone to death if infected.

Jy kan kies of jy negatief gaan reageer, of dit as uitdagings beskou wat betekenis aan jou lewenspad gee.

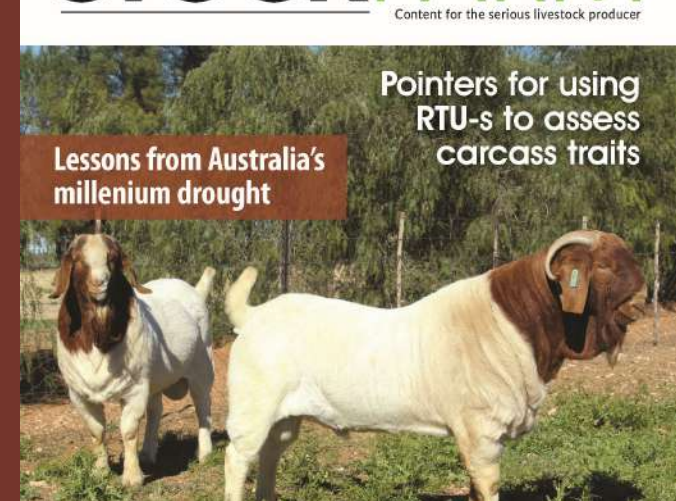

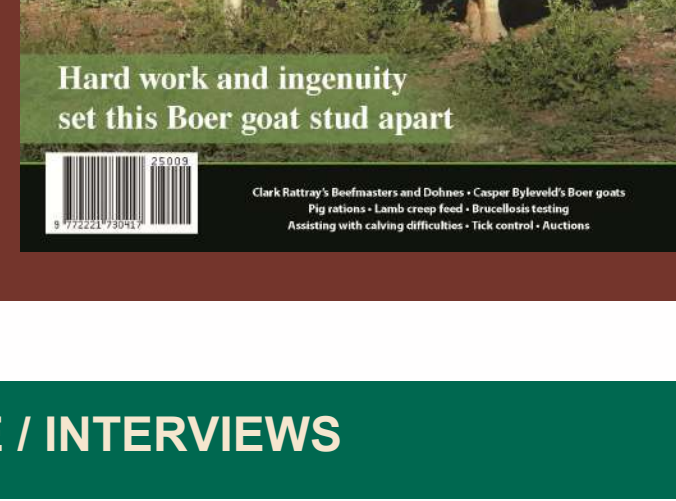
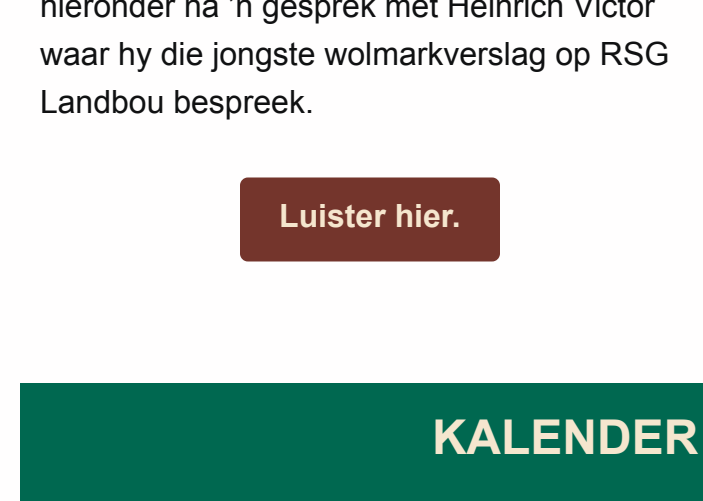


Merino's waarop jy kan staatmaak
