

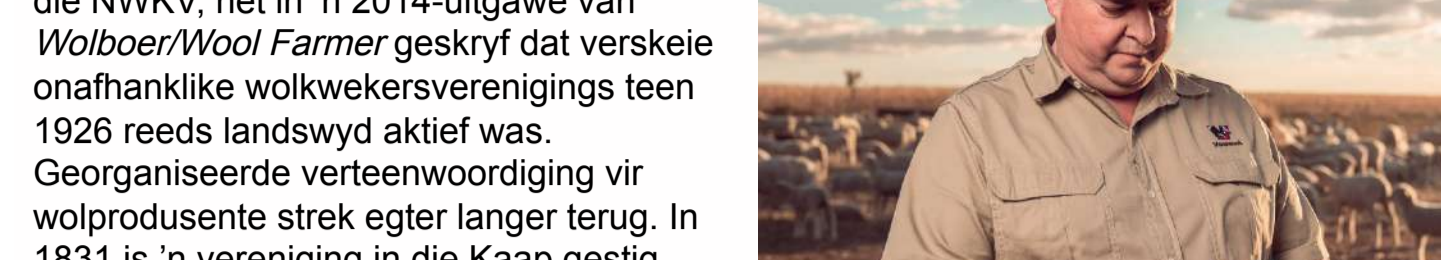

Wolklassering en die Springbokkop: 100 van NWKV-uitnemendheid

Anneltz Smit van Niekkerk van die Nasionale Wolkwekwersvereniging (NWKV) het tydens 'n Plaas TV-onderhoud met Lise Roberts oor wolklassering en die gesogte Springbokkop-sertifisering gesels:



100 jaar van wolproduksie (Deel 2): Institusionele konsolidasie en piekproduksie (1926 tot 1996)

Die Nasionale Wolkwekwersvereniging (NWKV) is op 28 Mei 1926 tydens 'n wolkonferensie in Middelburg in die Kaap gestig. Hoewel die organisasie eers in 1929 formeel gestalte gekry het, word die vroeëre datum as die stigtingsdatum erken en word die eeufees in 2026 gevier.

Leon de Beer, voormalige bestuurder van die NWKV, het in 'n 2014-uitgawe van *Wolboer/Wool Farmer* geskryf dat verskeie onafhanklike wolkwekwersverenigings teen 1926 reeds landswyd aktief was. Georganiseerde verteenwoordiging vir wolproduksie strek egter langer terug. In 1831 is 'n vereniging in die Kaap gestig om Merino-telling te bevorder.

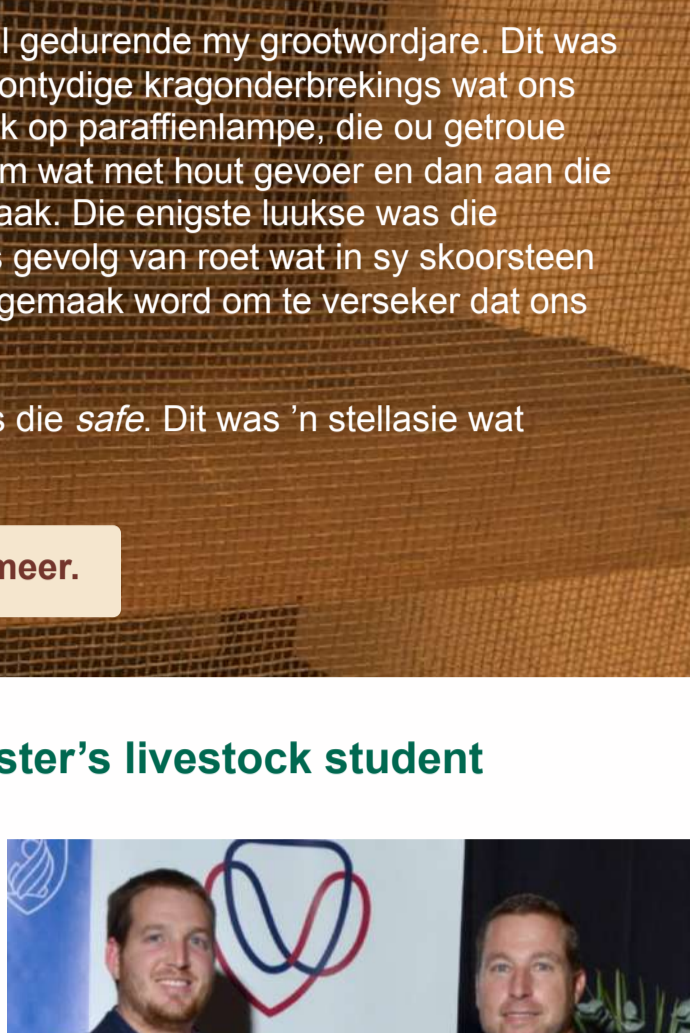
Dit is gevolg deur die stigting van die Nasionale Vereniging vir Wol- en Bokhaarkwekers in Port Elizabeth in 1906, en die Dewetsdorp Wolproduksievereniging in 1907 vir die Oranjerivierkolonie. In 1918 is die Transvaalse Skaap- en Bokproduksie-organisasie op die been gebring.

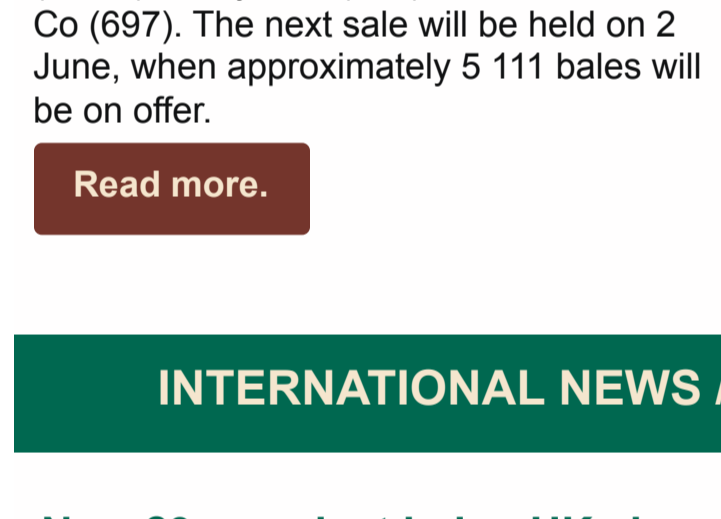

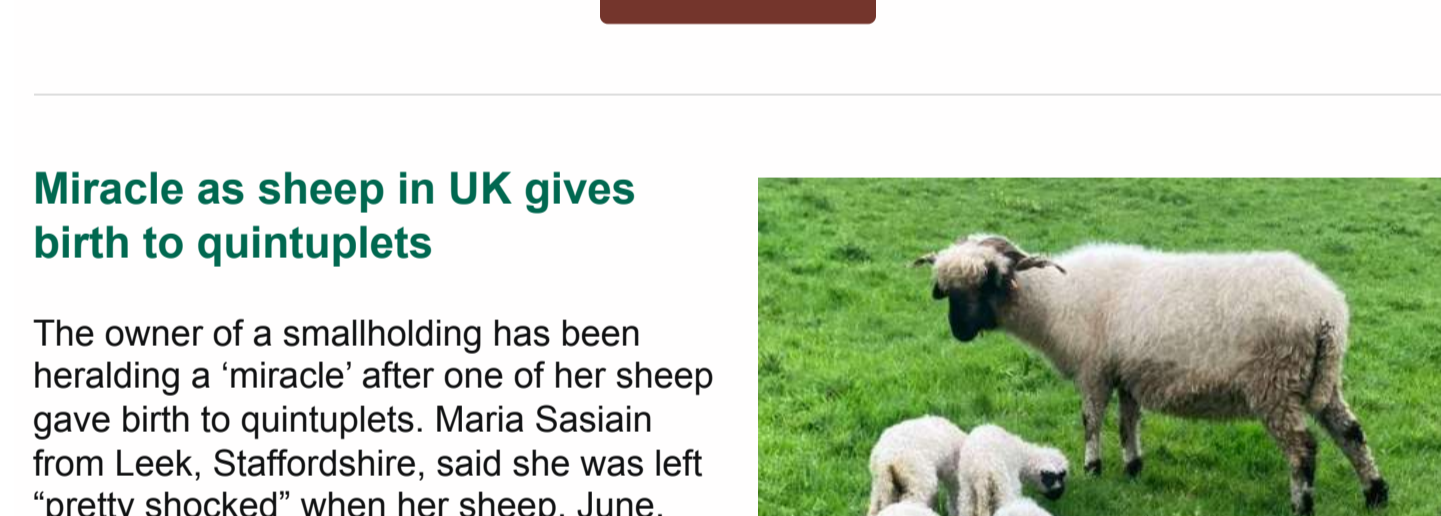
2026 NAMPO Oesdag 'n goeie vertoewensvenster vir die wolbedryf

National wool market report for 20 May 2026

The wool selling season saw a smaller offering of 5 284 bales on the 32nd sale of the season held on 20 May. Approximately half of the offering consisted of long-length, fine-micron wools, with 66.3% of the merino wools offered being sustainably certified.



Although the ZAR strengthened throughout the day's trade, it still averaged weaker against the US\$, which supported the current market levels.

Individual quality clips once again performed well, achieving an outstanding overall sales clearance of 96.2%. The all-indicator edged up 0.7% to close on R265.80/kg, with the certified indicator closing 0.7% higher on R273.01/kg. The highest price of R344.46/kg (clean) (R202.50/kg greasy) was paid for a single bale lot of 17.6-micron merino wool.



The Australian market traded slightly higher by 0.2% (AUS), compared to their previous sale held on Wednesday, 13 May.

The major buyers on the stock were Standard Wool SA (1 306), G Modiano SA (1 089), Tanyu SA (764) and Stucken & Co (697). The next sale will be held on 2 June, when approximately 5 111 bales will be on offer.

New £3m project helps UK sheep producers reduce emissions and boost efficiency

Funded by the United Kingdom's Department for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs' (Defra) Farming Innovation Programme, the research has been carried out by Innovate UK, alongside 11 industry-wide partners, including the National Sheep Association (NSA).



NSA chief executive Phil Stocker said: "From the outset, the Breed for CH4Age project aimed to improve the wider sheep industry and breeders, while providing practical strategies to improve ewe efficiency and reduce methane emissions. I hope all sheep breeders can now benefit from what this project has achieved."

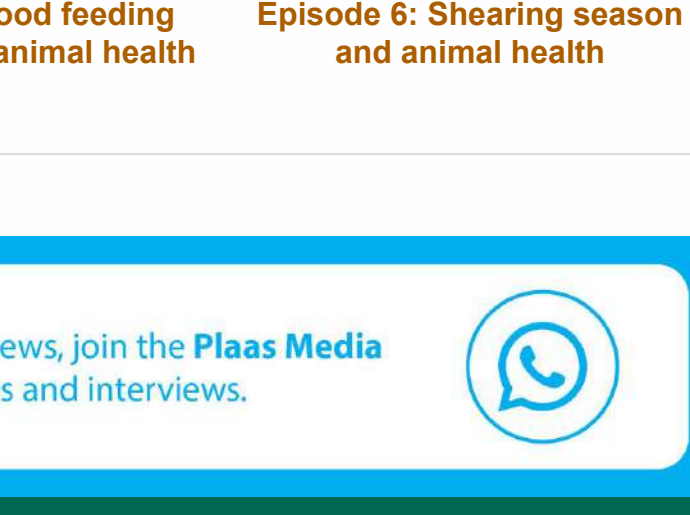


The shepherdess recalled the night of the lambs' births, which included her daughter repeatedly shouting to her: "There's another one."

Blowfly risk in UK high as forecast turns almost fully red

The Scottish Sustainable Control of Parasites in Sheep (SCOPS) forecast, which displays when blowflies are projected to leave overwintered pupae, is now largely red.



This implies flies are emerging, or have already emerged, across most regions, including areas in Scotland where blowfly strike risk is not usually prevalent at this early stage of the season.

Regenerative agriculture improves productivity and profitability while reducing greenhouse gas emissions on Australian sheep farms

Regenerative agriculture can be deconstructed into several constituent practices, including adaptive multi-paddock (AMP) grazing, improved biodiversity, silvopasture, and minimising cultivation and synthetic fertiliser inputs. Here, using farms across a rainfall gradient, Australian researchers examined how three constituents – pasture species composition, antecedent soil organic carbon (SOC) and AMP grazing – influenced SOC accrual, greenhouse gas emissions, production, and profitability.

Skaapbrandsiekte: Klein myte, groot skade

Brandsiekte onder skape laat hom nie beperk tot een kudde of plaas nie en kan soos 'n veldbrand versprei. Die siekte raak maklik buite beheer en is dertwee as 'n aanneembare siekte geklassifiseer. Vanweë die ernste aard daarvan, kan die Nasionale Departement van Landbou en provinsiale owerheids ingryp indien 'n uitbreking voorkom.

Dr Willie Harris, 'n veearts van Noord-Kaap Repro en Veeratsenydienste op Upington, sê brandsiekte word veroorsaak deur die myt, *Psoroptes ovis*, wat op die vel van skape en bokke leef. As 'n dier eers besmet is, verduidelik die mytoplasma elke ses dae. Dit neem gemiddeld ses tot agt weke voordat ernstige kliniese tekens sigbaar word, en binne twee tot drie maande kan die siekte deur 'n hele kudde versprei.

Dohne Merino-produkte en navoerers het reeds in die laaste 190's koppe by mekaar gesoek, ter hulle die sorte van wolle en vleisproduksie beter kan laat klop. Die Dohne Merino-telersgenootskap is in 1966 gestig met Roelie te Kroux as hul eerste president.

Die invloed van individuele spasietekening op lammers se voer- en waterinname

As gevolg van 'n gebrek aan inligting oor hoe dierewelsyn en -welstand in voerkraai bestuur word, is verbruikers geneig om ongegronde menings oor intensiewe veeproduksie en die gepaardgaande welsynsmoontlikhede te lug. Navorsing is daarom onontbeerlik om te bepaal hoe die welsyn en produksie van lammers deur binnenshuise voerkraai beïnvloed word, sodat verbruikers die korrekte inligting kan ontvang.

In hierdie reeks ondersoek en bespreek ons die invloed van veedigheid op onderskeidelike die groei, welstand en vlesigehalte van lammers wat in 'n binnenshuise voerkraaistelsel afgevoerd word. Deel 1 behels voer- en waterinname.
